For several years the boys from Sartorius House have been helping Jersey Heritage prepare for the Fête Du Cidre by picking the apples in the orchard at Hamptonne Country Life Museum. We are pleased to advise that it is back again this year!

As well as the community involvement, we will have, as always, a fundraising aspect to the event. We hope that, whether they can attend on the day or not, each student will be able to raise a minimum of £20 through sponsorship or donations towards our international house charity - Sightsavers. By raising £20, a student is able to help fund Sightsavers to perform a sight-saving trachoma operation on a young person in countries such as India, Bangladesh and across several countries in Africa.

Boys should wear hardwearing clothes and closed shoes (walking shoes/wellies are ideal) and the addition of red items of clothing is more than welcomed. Students may need sun protection, snacks and hydration. To maximise our efforts, I plan to split the year groups as follows.
