Activities Week 2024

We want to provide flexibility but also clear expectations and support to facilitate this. Options are as follows:

- 1. Participation in a CCF Activity for those who are members of the Cadet Force
- 2. Assistance with an advertised Activities Week junior or middle school activity at College
- 3. Application for Leave of Absence in order to undertake a week of formal work experience or work shadowing. Please note that students are classed as being in full-time education for this week and therefore they will not be permitted to undertake paid employment during this time
- 4. Your permission for your son to work at home on his university application, CV or academic coursework;
- 5. Attend College during normal school hours for this week and an extended project will be set by subject Heads of Departments to further academic development in relevant subject areas.**

If your son would like any help with arranging a week of work experience then he should speak with Mrs Job as soon as possible. I have attached the Activities Week Choice Form which should be returned to Mrs Anderson (Assistant to the Head of Sixth Form) on a.anderson@vcj.sch.je by no later than Friday 7 June.

**If we do not receive the Form making clear the preferred choice by the deadline, then the default option will be this for the week.
